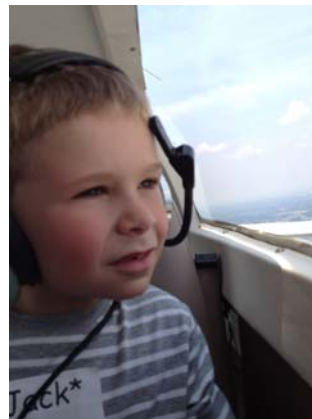


Who's got the keys?
